Publishing Ardora content on Moodle 2.X

+ Add an activity or resource

When we create content with Ardora, all the files will be created in a directory folder. Let's assume we have created a package of activities about the Past Simple tense and Ardora saved all the files in the folder "simplepastactivities".

To publish the activity on Moodle, follow these steps:

- 1.- Compress in a zip file the folder simplepastactivities ► simplepastactivities.zip
- 2.- We launch Moodle 2.x and choose the place where to publish the activity. Obviously, we need to have permissions as administrators or teachers in our moodle course.




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


3.- Click on the option + Add an activity or a resource A window will pop up with ACTIVITIES and RESOURCES. We then choose the File option in RESOURCES (1) and click on the "Add" button (2).

A window will open asking for the name of the resource we want to publish and we will name it as "Simple Past Activities". Further down in the same window, we will have to drag the compressed folder with the activity previously named as "simplepastactivities.zip" to the selected area:



The activity or package files are then uploaded to Moodle. Once stored on Moodle it would look like this:






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
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Now, we use the right mouse button to click on the added zip file. It will allow us to unzip it, which is the option we will choose:




It will take a few seconds and once completed, we will see the folder containing the unzipped activity.


Select files



We now access the unzipped folder, "simplepastactivities" We have to find the htm file that launches the activity; in our example: simplepastactivities.htm:

Click on this file and then set it as the main file.





When you have set up the main file, the activity will already be published successfully on Moodle.

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We can now save the changes and return to the Moodle course.



By clicking on the link provided, the package will be launched.
